CLOSING ADDRESS OF THE PRESIDENT OF CIEC

Dear President of the Organisational Committee,

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Dear colleagues,

At the termination of the 3rd International Symposium on "Water and Fertilizer Use for Food Production in Arid and Semi-arid Zones" today here in Benghazi, I can state, as the President of CIEC, that this Symposium was one of the most important forums of scientists and specialists in the fields of water and fertilization, of agronomists, irrigation engineers and the fertilizer industry. Delegates from 18 countries in semi-arid and arid zones on 4 continents, more than 130 participants and representatives of many interested international organizations have taken part in this symposium. The Symposium emphasized the fact that water and fertilizers are very important factors for increasing world food production.
